



PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON THE FORMER QUINTA CLUB

We are continuing our consultation that started in March 2021 and we are grateful to everyone who has taken part and provided feedback so far. These proposals would renovate the derelict former Quinta Club building and create a new home Barnet's School Libraries Resources Service (SLRS).

The SLRS is currently based in Hendon Library, where it has limited and sub-standard space. The Hendon Hub project is an opportunity to relocate the SLRS to a new location and facility. This will allow for an improved service for Barnet schools.

The SLRS is a service that supports teaching and learning by loaning books and resources to local schools. It is not a public library and the site would primarily be visited by staff, occasional delivery vehicles and those attending training workshops for school staff.


To allow more time for feedback, we have taken the decision to further extend the consultation.

All presentations will take place online 6pm-7.30pm, and the dates are as follows:




ONLINE BUT WANT THE SAME INFORMATION?
