

# PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON HENDON HUB

**The Hendon Hub Project is an exciting and transformational plan which will integrate new academic, community and civic spaces along The Burroughs in Hendon.**

Our aim is to create a development that everyone can be proud of and which will deliver significant new investment into this area.

We are continuing our consultation that started in March 2021 and we are grateful to everyone who has taken part and provided feedback so far

As part of our continuing consultation we have identified a number of potential changes that could be made to the proposals, responding to the feedback we've received. To allow more time for feedback, we have taken the decision to further extend the consultation. **Our public consultation will now close on Friday 4 June 2021.**

- We want to understand from residents, businesses and community groups how parking is used in the area, so we can ensure that we re-provide all the parking that is reasonably required
- The project is not predicted to be affected by the short-term impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and will assist with the economic recovery of the borough.
